



The Capital and Coast health system at work, April to June 2025

We treated **14,677** people in the emergency departments.

We completed **52** knee and **47** hip replacements.

We completed **3,423** elective treatments.

Achieved **91%** general practice enrolment.

We vaccinated **4,894** tamariki aged 0 to 4 years old.

We completed **50** ear grommet and **588** cataract procedures.

There were **809** online general practice appointments.
