

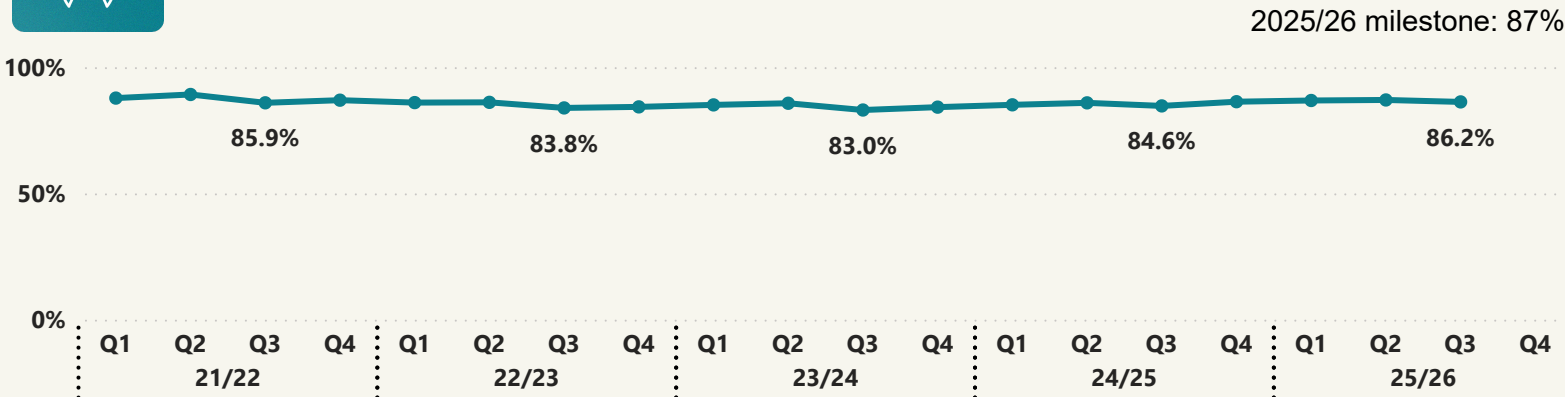

2030 target: 90% of patients to receive cancer treatment within 31 days of the decision to treat

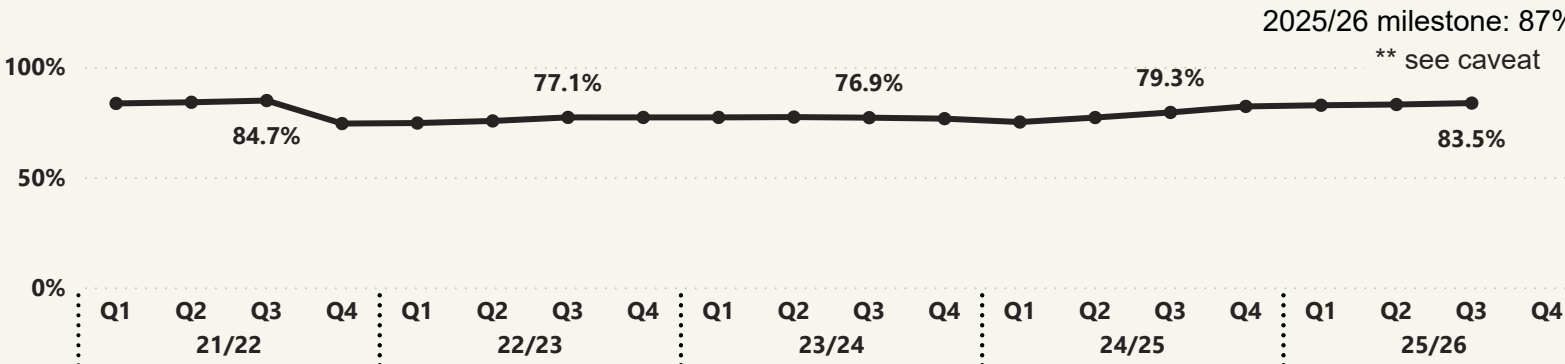

2030 target: 95% children fully immunised by 24 months of age

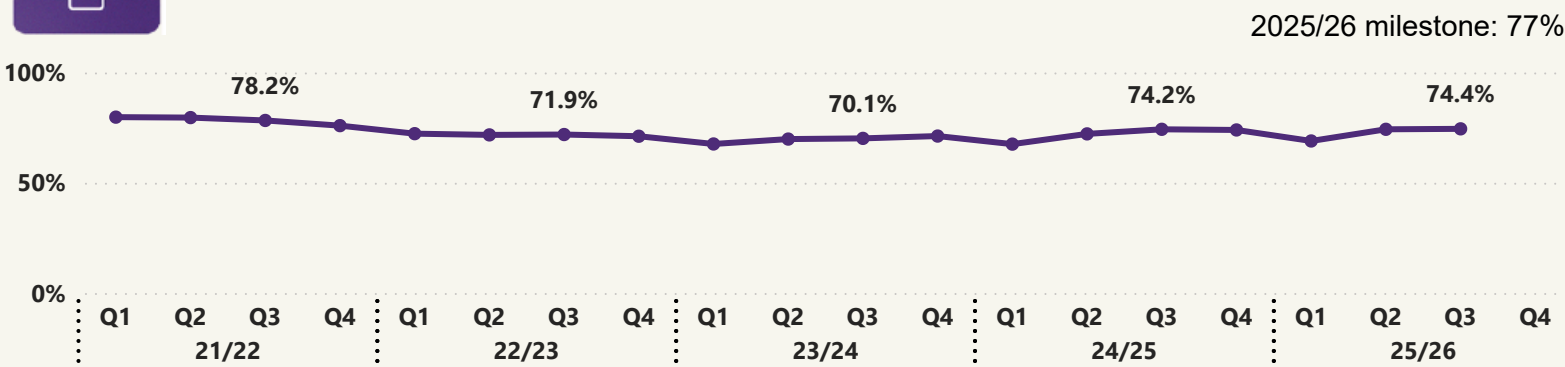

2030 target: 95% patients to be admitted, discharged or transferred from an ED within 6 hours

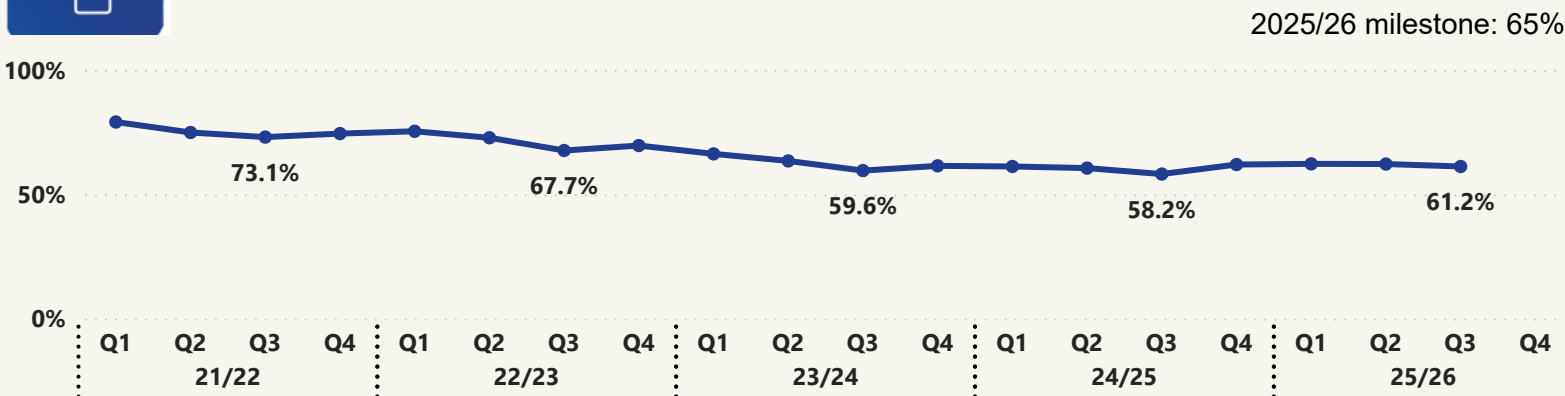

2030 target: 95% of people wait less than four months for a first specialist assessment

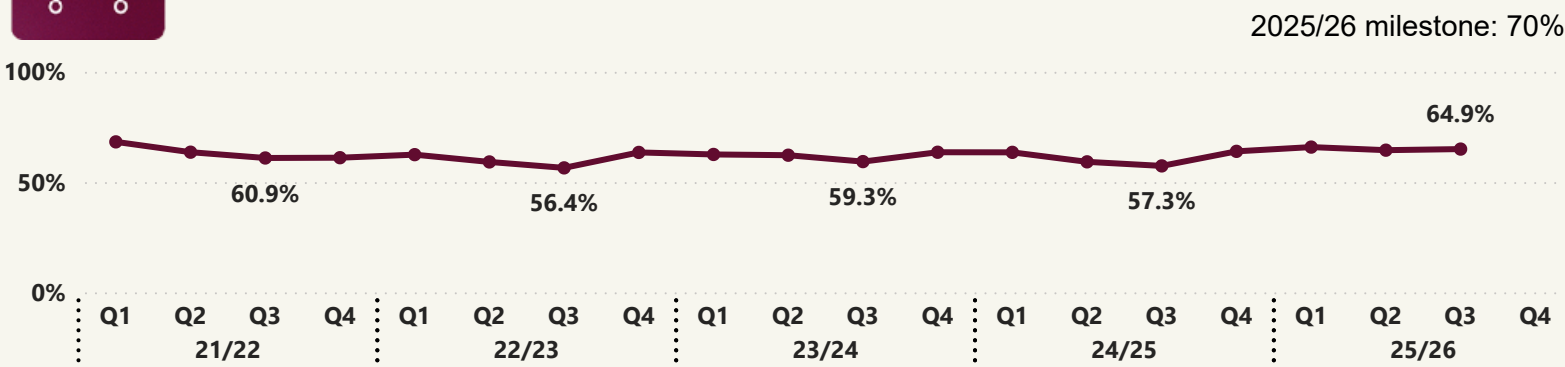
